All Around the Town EXHIBITION GUIDELINES

- ~ Open to all amateur and professional artists, regardless of residency. Each artist may submit up to three works during the application period (Sept 26 Oct 20, 2023). Send to: director@artattheemerson.com
- ~ Works must be original and depict familiar or recognizable views or aspects of Vero Beach. This can include popular landmarks, historical sights, institutions, signage, unique architecture, city/public parks, residential and retail areas, special events, lifestyle, or culture, just to name a few.
- ~ Work will be accepted in the order applications* and images* are received, and space permits. We have wall space for approximately 35-40 works. The number of works actually displayed will depend on the linear feet of works submitted and may vary. Please limit submissions to under 40 inches wide, including framing. This will allow us to include as many artists as possible. Oversized works will be considered by special request and as space permits.

Please Note: The method of accepting applications to exhibit in this show (i.e., in the order they are received) applies to this show only.

- ~ All two-dimensional media, including but not limited to painting, drawing, photography, digital art, mixed media, collage/assemblage, and fiber, are welcome. Artworks can be in any style or technique. Included artists will be notified via email on Monday, October 23, 2023, with delivery information.
- ~ All work must be professionally presented and ready to hang. Our hanging system requires sturdy wire with D-Rings or similar. Sawtooth hangers or screw eyes simply don't work. Sorry! Hanging begins immediately following the delivery period.
- ~ Gallery-wrapped canvases must be at least 1.5 inches deep to qualify for wrapping.
- ~ Delivery is by drop-off (Nov 2) and pick-up only (Jan 3). ~ We cannot accept shipped work, nor store any packaging materials.
- ~ There are no entry fees associated with exhibiting at the Galleries at the Emerson. However, exhibiting artists are responsible for hosting the Meet-the-Artists Reception, tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, November 8th, 5:30-7:00 pm.
- ~ Sales will be encouraged. The Emerson suggests a 30% 'donation' by the artist on sales.
- ~ Buyers are encouraged to take their purchases with them at the time of payment, allowing the selling artist to replace the sold piece with another of similar size and theme. Individual artists are responsible for collecting and reporting applicable sales taxes in accordance with Florida law.
